Sealed bids for the construction of the Biological Treatment Tank Improvements will be received by the South Huron Valley Utility Authority (SHVUA), SHV Wastewater Treatment Plant, 34001 W. Jefferson Ave., Brownstown, Michigan 48173 until **2:00 p.m., Local Time on Tuesday June 7, 2016**, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contract will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

Retrofit of two existing Biological Treatment tanks including removal of precast concrete tank covers, removal of mixing and aeration equipment, installation of new handrails and guardrails around tanks, installation of new aeration equipment in tanks, air piping in piping gallery, valves and new aeration blowers with associated electrical work and site work.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Proposal Guarantee

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the bid forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the South Huron Valley Utility Authority in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Bid Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract within the hold period. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least 180 days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

The Owner reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.

Award of Contract

The South Huron Valley Utility Authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, select the successful qualified bidder, and to waive any informality or irregularities in bidding should it consider same to be in its best interest. The successful qualified bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory performance, labor and material bonds, maintenance and guarantee bond and insurance polices.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

Pre-Bid Meeting

A **mandatory** pre-bid meeting will be held at the South Huron Valley WWTP located at 34001 West Jefferson Avenue, Brownstown Township, Michigan, on **Tuesday, May 17, 2016 at 9:00 a.m.** local time. Representatives of the Owner and the Consulting Engineers will be present to discuss the Project. All prime bidders are required to attend the meeting. The meeting will include a site tour. All those participating in the site tour are required to wear hard hats, safety shoes, and safety glasses. Participants must provide their own personal protective equipment. This will be the only opportunity for bidders to review the site.
