

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS  
2016 ROAD REHABILITATION PROGRAM  
VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN  
OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN

Sealed proposals for the 2015 Road Rehabilitation Program will be received by the Village Clerk for the Village of Franklin until **11:00 a.m., Local Time on Tuesday, June 21, 2016** at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contract will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

There are four (4) potential Divisions of work in this project (Divisions A, B, C and D), depending on the availability of Village funds. The scope of Divisions A through C is to pulverize the existing HMA pavement, shape, compact and place a new 4" HMA road section on top of the pulverized, compacted material. There is also a fourth division of work – Division D - consisting of proposed miscellaneous repairs to existing HMA pavement, including HMA pavement mill and overlay (2") and full-depth HMA pavement removal and base repair construction. The actual locations of the work in Division D will be determined after bids are taken and will include pavement rehabilitation on various residential (local) roads and will most likely include work on some of the Village-owned major roads, such as Wellington and Scenic Highway. As the Proposal states, the Owner reserves the right to award any of the aforementioned Divisions alone (Division A, B, C or D) or any combination of the Divisions, depending on the availability of funds. All Divisions must be quoted in order for the bid to be considered responsive.

The project will be awarded in early July, 2016 with commencement expected by early August, 2016 and final completion by Saturday, October 29, 2016.

A non-refundable payment of Forty-Five (\$45.00) Dollars, **CHECK ONLY, payable to “Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.”** will be required for each set of Drawings and Specifications. Drawings and Specifications can be shipped by U.P.S. ground for a shipping and handling charge of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars, CHECK ONLY, non-refundable, to Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

**Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.**

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the Village of Franklin in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the Village of Franklin. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least sixty (60) days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

The Village reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.

No Proposal will be received unless made on blanks furnished and delivered to the Village Clerk on or before **11:00 a.m., Local Time on Tuesday, June 21, 2016.**
