

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS  
2017/2018 ROAD REHABILITATION PROGRAM  
VILLAGE OF FRANKLIN  
OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN

Sealed proposals for the 2017/2018 Road Rehabilitation Program will be received by the Village Clerk for the Village of Franklin until **3:00 p.m., Local Time on Tuesday, April 18, 2017** at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contract will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

**The Owner intends to award one (1) contract consisting of Phase I and Phase II.** It is anticipated that Phase I will be constructed in 2017. Phase II will not be allowed to proceed until Phase I is completed and accepted by the Village. It is anticipated that Phase II will be constructed during the 2018 construction season. The Village is also seeking unit prices for the rehabilitation of Franklin Road from 14 Mile Road to the southern Village limits, which is indicated as an Alternate Bid in the Proposal. The award of the 2017/2018 Road Rehabilitation Program will be based upon the total combined bid of Phases I and II; however, depending on federal aid and local fund availability in 2018, the Alternate Bid may also be authorized in 2018 and thus, **the Village will require that Phase I, Phase II, and the Alternate Bid are quoted in order for the overall bid to be considered responsive.**

The approximate quantities for **Phase I** are as follows:

**Phase II quantities in the Proposal were projected and will need to be adjusted following the completion of Phase I, during the final design phase for Phase II work. All unit prices bid for Phase II shall be held until project completion. In addition, the Alternate Bid unit prices shall also be held until project completion.**

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Copies of Plans and Specifications and Proposal Forms will be available on or after **12:00 Noon, Local Time on Tuesday, April 04, 2017**, at the offices of Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc., Consulting Engineers, 555 Hulet Drive, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan 48302-0360. A non-refundable payment of One Hundred and Ninety-Five (\$195.00) Dollars, **CHECK ONLY, payable to** "Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc." will be required for each set of Drawings and Specifications. Drawings and Specifications can be shipped by U.P.S. ground for a shipping and handling charge of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars, CHECK ONLY, non-refundable, to Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

**Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.**

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the Village of Franklin in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the Village of Franklin. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least ninety (90) days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

The Village reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.

No Proposal will be received unless made on blanks furnished and delivered to the Village Clerk on or before **3:00 p.m., Local Time on Tuesday, April 18, 2017.**
