

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
2018 ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM
VILLAGE OF BEVERLY HILLS
OAKLAND COUNTY

Sealed proposals for the construction of the 2018 Road Improvement Program will be received by the Village of Beverly Hills until 11 am., Local Time on Thursday, September 20, 2018, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

The first division of the 2018 Road Improvement Program shall consist of the removal of approximately 6,000 syds of existing asphalt pavement and installation of approximately 1,320 tons of HMA along 14 Mile Rd west of Lahser Rd. The second division of the project consists of 160 feet of curb removal and replacement, the rehabilitation of 7 catch basins, and the removal and replacement of approximately 160 syds of existing asphalt within the Westwood Common Subdivision.

Copies of Plans and Specifications and Proposal Forms shall be available on or after Tuesday, September 4, 2018 at the offices of Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc., Consulting Engineers, 555 Hulet Drive, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan 48302-0360.

A non-refundable payment of SEVENTY-FIVE (\$75.00) Dollars, **CHECK ONLY, payable to** "Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc." will be required for each set of Drawings and Specifications. Drawings and Specifications can be shipped by U.P.S. ground for a shipping and handling charge of FIFTEEN (\$15.00) Dollars, CHECK ONLY, non-refundable, to Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc. The Bidder is advised that to submit a bid on this project, the Bidder must have purchased a set of Drawings and Specifications from Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the Village of Beverly Hills in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the Village of Beverly Hills. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least Ninety (90) days.

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The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

The Village of Beverly Hills reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.

No Proposal will be received unless made on blanks furnished and delivered to the Village Clerk on or before 11 a.m., Local time, Thursday, September 20, 2018.
